

A Place for Wounded Missouri Veteran to Call Home

Express Scripts participated in a May 27 concert fund-raiser at the St. Charles Family Arena for St. Louis native, Marine Todd Nicely.

On March 26, 2010, Todd was returning to camp after a routine security patrol when he took the lead of his platoon of 12 Marines while crossing a bridge in the Helmand province in Southern Afghanistan. He stepped on a pressure plate detonating an improvised explosive device. The blast took both of his arms and legs, but not his spirit. Cpl. Nicely tells people he remembers thinking that he needed to keep breathing so he could stay alive and come home to his wife and family.

Express Scripts donated \$25,000 to help build Corporal Nicely a Smart Home in Missouri and employees raised another \$5,000. Express Scripts, the pharmacy benefit manager for the Department of Defense, supports 9.7 million beneficiaries.
