To thank the employees of Express Scripts for providing hope and help to the Wounded Warriors of the Armed Forces, the Tunnel to Towers Foundation presented George Paz with a replica of a NASCAR hood that ran at the Richmond International Raceway on Sept. 9, 2011. John Hodge, cousin of deceased firefighter, Stephen Stiller, presented the NASCAR hood to George Paz, chairman & CEO, at the most recent TRICARE Pharmacy Division meeting.

The NASCAR hood, along with an encased model of the official race car from the September 2011 event will be permanently displayed for all employees to enjoy. A plaque hung above the model car carries a heartfelt message to our employees for their generosity.
