Dear TRICARE Beneficiary:

Our records show you may be taking prescription drug(s) that will move to a non-preferred (Tier 3 non-formulary) status or may require prior authorization. The attached "Formulary Options for Your Doctor to Consider" lists all drug(s) affected by this change as well as the date that the change will take effect. It also lists preferred drug options for you and your doctor to consider. We recommend you discuss your options with your doctor before this change becomes effective.

The attachment shows all preferred drugs with their cost shares. You can get these preferred drugs through TRICARE Pharmacy Home Delivery or at a retail network pharmacy. They may also be available at a military treatment facility (MTF) pharmacy (to find a military pharmacy, visit [www.tricare.mil/mtf](http://www.tricare.mil/mtf).) We encourage you to consider TRICARE Pharmacy Home Delivery as a convenient and less costly way to fill prescriptions for your maintenance medications if you cannot get to an MTF pharmacy. Please keep in mind, if you don't have an approval from Express Scripts, Inc. (ESI) for a drug that requires prior authorization, you will pay 100 percent of the drug's cost. Your doctor can request a prior authorization by calling ESI, the TRICARE Pharmacy contractor, at 1-(866)-684-4488.
