

## 90-Day Supplies Frequently Asked Questions

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### 1. What is a 90-day supply network?

It's a new feature of your prescription plan. With it, you have three ways to get up to a 90-day supply of your daily medications (those drugs you take regularly for ongoing conditions, such as high blood pressure, diabetes or high cholesterol, or products like oral contraceptives). You can conveniently fill those prescriptions at any retail participating pharmacy, the Amazon Pharmacy or Express Scripts® Pharmacy. Filling a 90-day supply could even save you money compared to filling three 30-day supplies.

### 2. How many retail pharmacies are available to me?

You can go to any participating retail pharmacy. If you need help locating one, log into [express-scripts.com/findapharmacy](https://express-scripts.com/findapharmacy)

### 3. What happens if I keep filling my daily medication like I'm doing now?

If you keep filling a 30-day supply instead of a 90-day supply, you'll continue to pay what you're currently paying. The choice is completely up to you.

### 4. Is there a scenario where a 30-day fill is preferable to a 90-day fill?

Yes. If, for instance, you are just getting started on a new medication or working with your prescriber to determine the appropriate dosage, it could be best to fill a 30-day supply until your therapy has stabilized.

### 5. What is the advantage of getting up to a 90-day supply vs. a 30-day supply?

One 90-day supply typically costs LESS than three 30-day supplies. You could save two copays a year — or an average of 29%. You'll save time making fewer trips to the pharmacy and pay just one payment every three months. Rest easy knowing you'll be less likely to miss a dose since you won't be refilling as often. You will pay the same copayment for your 90-day supply whether you fill through home delivery from Amazon Pharmacy, Express Scripts® Pharmacy or any participating retail pharmacy. \*

### 6. How do I get a 90-day supply of my medication?

A prescription written for dispensing in 90-day increments is required to obtain a 90-day supply of medication. Contact your prescriber to determine if 90-day supply fills are right for you. If you have been on the same medication for a while, many pharmacies will request a new prescription from your prescriber for you.

### 7. What is the difference between daily medications and my other medications?

Daily medications, also called long-term or maintenance medications, are those you take on an ongoing basis, to treat high blood pressure or high cholesterol. Daily medications might also be oral contraceptives, insulin, or anti-depressants. Medications not considered “daily” include antibiotics and others you take for short periods of time. Under your plan, you can fill these prescriptions at any participating retail pharmacy in your network.

### 8. I already use home delivery from Express Scripts® Pharmacy to get 90-day supplies of my daily medications. Do I need to change anything?
