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## How to use the formulary

The formulary is a list of preferred medications and other pharmacy products selected for inclusion based on clinical effectiveness, safety, and overall value. The formulary helps you and your doctor determine the right medication to prescribe to treat your needs. Medications are listed by category and placed in tiers, which are the different cost levels you pay for a medication.

Medications are listed in each category in alphabetical order. Brand-name medications are shown in uppercase letters, and generic medications are shown in lowercase letters.

Some medications on the formulary have certain processing requirements or limitations for coverage. These are identified by the letters listed in the table and defined in the abbreviations list on page 3 of the booklet.

## Benefit Coverage and Limitations

This printed formulary does not provide information regarding the specific benefit coverage and limitations an individual member may have. Different plans may have specific benefit exclusions, copays, or a lack of coverage that the formulary does not reflect.

The formulary applies only to outpatient medications prescribed to members. It does not apply to medications used in inpatient settings, such as the hospital, or administered by a health care provider in a clinic or office setting.

## Tier Benefit Design

The formulary is a tiered benefit design. Tiers are the different cost levels you pay for a medication.

\$0 – Medications covered under the ACA Preventative Healthcare and Essential Healthcare Benefits

Tier 1 – Low cost-share level; preferred generic medications

Tier 2 – Moderate cost-share level; preferred brand medications and some generic medications

Tier 3 – High cost-share level; non-preferred brand and generic medications

## Specialty Medications

Specialty medications are medications that are used to treat complex conditions such as cancer, hemophilia, multiple sclerosis and rheumatoid arthritis. Specialty medications are managed separately and not listed in this formulary document. 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## List of Abbreviations

**\$0:** Medications covered under the ACA Preventative Healthcare and Essential Healthcare Benefits

**1:** Low cost-share level; preferred generic medications

**2:** Moderate cost-share level; preferred brand medications and some generic medications

**3:** High cost-share level; non-preferred brand and generic medications

**ACA:** Affordable Care Act.

**PA:** Prior Authorization. The Plan requires you or your physician to get prior authorization for certain drugs. This means that you will need to get approval before you fill your prescriptions. If you don't get approval, we may not cover the drug.

**QL:** Quantity Limit. For certain drugs, the Plan limits the amount of the drug that we will cover.

**ST:** Step Therapy. In some cases, the Plan requires you to first try certain drugs to treat your medical condition before we will cover another drug for that condition. For example, if Drug A and Drug B both treat your medical condition, we may not cover Drug B unless you try Drug A first. If Drug A does not work for you, we will then cover Drug B.
